RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. All foals exhibited in class 7 must be at least 4 weeks old on the Showday
- 2. in all classes Judges` decision in final
- 3. Stallions and colts must be handled at all times by an experienced adult
- 4. No Horse/Pony must be left unattended when tied to Horsebox or Trailer
- 5. Canes/whips not exceed 75cm with the exception of Dressage Classes only
- 6. Exhibitors are reminded their need for adequate third party insurance
- 7. DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AND UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES
- 8. Members to have Competed in at least three Shows to qualify for End of Season Championships Show
- 9. The West Midlands Arabian Festival Shows and Hill Farm Proprietors, nor their Officers, Servants or Assistants. shall in any way be responsible for any loss, injury or damage from any cause or circumstances whatsoever to Exhibitors, their exhibits, servants, assistants or other member of the public, or any animals, property, vehicles, brought onto the Showground or premises used in conjunction with the Show, whilst entering or leaving the same or otherwise, anything else in connection with or arising out of or attributable to the Show or to the conditions, regulations, bye laws by Show Committee or by Hill Farm Proprietors, in relation thereto
- 10. Any person wishing to lodge a complaint having reference to any person or exhibit shall do so in writing within thirty minutes of the termination of the class in question, at the same time, shall deposit a sum of £30 with the Secretary. If, upon investigation by the Show Committee, the protest is not Sustained the deposit shall be forfeited to the funds of the Show
- 11. An Exhibitor may not knowingly exhibit an animal bred, sold, produced or leased by the Judge, his/her immediate family or employer
- 12. ENTRIES ACCEPTED ON THE ASSUMPTION THAT EXHIBITORS HAVE READ THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS
- 13. IT IS FORBIDDEN TO ADMINISTER ANY STIMULANT OR SEDATIVE, OR ANY SUBSTANCE OR CAUSE ONE TO BE ADMINISTERED TO AN EXHIBIT, IN ANY WAY, WITH THE OBJECT OF INFLUENCING THE EXHIBITS PERFORMANCE IN THE SHOWRING
